From the Sermon

Reconciliation does not mean pretending that nothing happened. It doesn't mean ignoring hurt or allowing harmful behaviour to continue. Sometimes grace says, "This is not acceptable." Sometimes grace requires strong boundaries. But grace also refuses to declare another person beyond redemption.

Jesus calls us to keep the door of reconciliation open. Again and again.

We don't give up on people simply because they make mistakes. We don't expect everyone to grow at the same speed or in the same way. We recognise that God is still at work in them—just as God is still at work in us.
